Old Business:

 - Someone motions to donate free movie passes for the HOWL movie.
 - Someone seconds the motion.
 - Motion passed verbally by The Board.

 - All the movies on the ballot are available through Swank.
 - Movie Choices:
 - Megamind
 - A number of Film Board members saw it as semi-social last semester.
 - Erin Chojnowski said that the forget-me stick was the best! (Others agreed with his statement.)
 - Most people know what this movie is. I'm not a big fan of Will Ferrell movies, but it's good.
 - Hereafter
 - It has Matt Damon in it.
 - We talked about this movie during the last voting session.
 - Basically, Matt Damon's a psychic and a school boy calls him out on it.
 - The Next Three Days
 - It has Russell Crowe in it.
 - (No one in Film Board has seen it.)
 - It didn't do too well on Rotten Tomatoes.
 - It's about a woman who is accused of murder, and her husband breaks her out.
 - Liam Neeson is also in it.
 - Faster
 - Jeff Saunders says the movie is cool.

- Current Publicity Officer's Table Tent Duties

- Randy says can that we could split the officer work and change Film Board's constitution, but it takes a minimum of three meetings to make a change in the constitution active.
- Erin Chojnowski says it takes three to five minutes to set the table tents up. It's walking from dorm to dorm that takes a while.
- Shannon says that the table tents can only be put up on Thursday.
- Carissa Lindeman volunteers to put up the table tents in DHH.
- Amie Chaloupka volunteers to put up the table tents in Wads.
- Shannon says that Jason can delegate the job to Film Board members, but the member can refuse the job if they don't want to do it.
- Sulgee Haynesworth volunteers to put up table tents in McNair.
- Jason says he will compensate them a little bit for putting up the table tents.
