### Old Business

#### MUB Movie

- Narrowed down list
  - Moana
  - Madagascar
  - Lilo & Stitch
  - Jungle Book – original
  - Cast Away
  - PotC: Curse of the Black Pearl
  - Jumanji 2017
- We will probably pick 2
  - MUB can contribute \$800
  - Rights for each will probably be 500-700
  - Will definitely show Pirates
    - Second movie (if we show two) will be Jumanji
- Dates
  - Tuesday & Thursday – proposed

#### Final Schedule

- Nanocon movie needs to be decided
- Alita Battle Angel – will it make money?
  - Box office/ratings are a general guide, not a guarantee
  - The movie plot is placed in the middle of an existing story – not great for audiences unfamiliar with the story
  - Animation is good
  - Alternative: LEGO Movie 2 for two weeks
    - Not many other options
    - Should be cheaper than Wreck it Ralph 2
    - Slightly more expensive than one week
    - Benefit – people who will be studying on Final Exam weekend can go the first week
  - Could we show Spiderverse/Aquaman for two weeks?
    - Issue – 2001 is set in stone, Nanocon is after, there would be a two week gap where we couldn't show Spiderverse/Aquaman's second weekend
  - Could we re-show Infinity War?
    - Before Endgame
    - Show as the last movie
    - We lost money last time

- Avengers movies are not rewatchable
- A strong movie at the end of the semester does well, weaker movies do terrible
  - Infinity War, then LEGO Movie 2 might work better if we do both
- Free Shakespeare weekend
  - For Shakespeare's birthday
  - Requested by one student
  - Probably wouldn't do well
- LEGO Movie 2 showing twice could reduce the strength of the movie
- If we can only show one movie with MUB, why don't we show the second on that open weekend?
- First Man – space movies tend to do well at Tech
  - First Man is a good movie
  - Biopic of Neil Armstrong
- People sometimes don't come to Film Board movies because they are too lazy
  - Infinity War is on Netflix, will not encourage this demographic to come
- LEGO Movie (the original) had a number of kids showing up multiple times, could be good to show for 2 weekends
- 4 in favor of Alita, the rest in favor of showing LEGO Movie 2 for two weekends
